Dr Lushiku Nkombua is a Family Physician and Head of the Clinical Unit at Middelburg Hospital, Mpumalanga, with a special interest in chronic diseases, especially diabetes. His quality improvement projects since 2010 include clinic audits and the Provincial Chronic Disease Forum, which developed clinical guidelines for the major Non Communicable Diseases (Asthma, Hypertension, Epilepsy & Diabetes). Before this he worked as a Medical Officer and then Senior Specialist at Middelburg Hospital, and had various posts throughout Mpumalanga & Limpopo. His international experience includes working in Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of Congo, as a medical officer, and in family Medicine in Canada.

In addition to his clinical work he is involved in training MBChB and BCMP students and Family Medicine registrars, as well as organising the Family Physicians Forum in Mpumalanga, an annual Ethics Conference and various CPD training events in Mpumalanga. Dr Nkombua has published a number of articles on diabetes, cardiology PHC, and trauma in peer reviewed journals and has presented at local and international conferences.
